The participants funded by scholarships are expected to take active and full part in the conference program. Reimbursements will be made on the basis of registered attendance. If the participant fails to take part in at least 75% of the conference program, ILGA-Europe reserves the right to not reimburse the participant’s travel costs. An information letter will also be sent to the organization this person comes from and that person will not be eligible for scholarship for the following two events organised by ILGA-Europe.

The only exception to the above mentioned rule is a reduced participation to the conference program because of duties connected to the conference, such as, for instance, the need to take part in a charring pool meetings having been elected to the charring pool.

In accepting the scholarship, participants will be asked to formally agree to all of the above. Failure to agree to the above rules will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.
