ILGA-Europe offers scholarships for activists who would otherwise be unable to participate in the conference for financial reasons. We are only able to offer a very limited number of scholarships this year, and therefore encourage you to seek funding in advance within your organisation or from available funding sources (e.g. Mama Cash, travel grants from local Open Society foundations, etc.).

Scholarships will be awarded according to the following criteria:

- priority will be given to women;
- there is a limited number of scholarships for representatives of transgender organisations;
- geographical location of the organisation
- contribution to the work of ILGA-Europe and/or the LGBT movement in Europe.

Scholarship applicants will be informed of the result of the selection process as soon as decisions have been made and confirmation of funding for scholarships has been received.

Your application will be assessed on your motivation and applicability of the skills gained during the conference in your LGBT work. Therefore, brief one-sentence general answers reduce your chances of getting a scholarship.

The participants funded by scholarships are expected to take active and full part in the conference program. Reimbursements will be made on the basis of registered attendance. If the participant fails to take part in at least 75% of the conference program, ILGA-Europe reserves the right not to reimburse the participant's travel costs. An information letter will also be sent to the organization the person comes from and that person will not be eligible for scholarship for the following two events organised by ILGA-Europe.

The only exception to the above mentioned rule is a reduced participation to the conference program because of duties connected to the conference, such as, for instance, the need to take part in a chairing pool meetings having been elected to the chairing pool.

In accepting the scholarship, participants will be asked to formally agree to all of the above. Failure to agree to the above rules will result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.
