PERSECUTION:

- death penalty: 7 countries
- imprisonment: 77 countries and 6 entities*

PROTECTION:

- anti-discrimination laws: 48 countries and 33 entities

RECOGNITION:

- recognition and registration for same-sex unions: 19 countries and 14 entities

* include part of a federation, state, province, federal district, any other administrative and/or territorial unit
