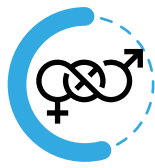
Share of Europeans that say that in their country discrimination is widespread\* based on

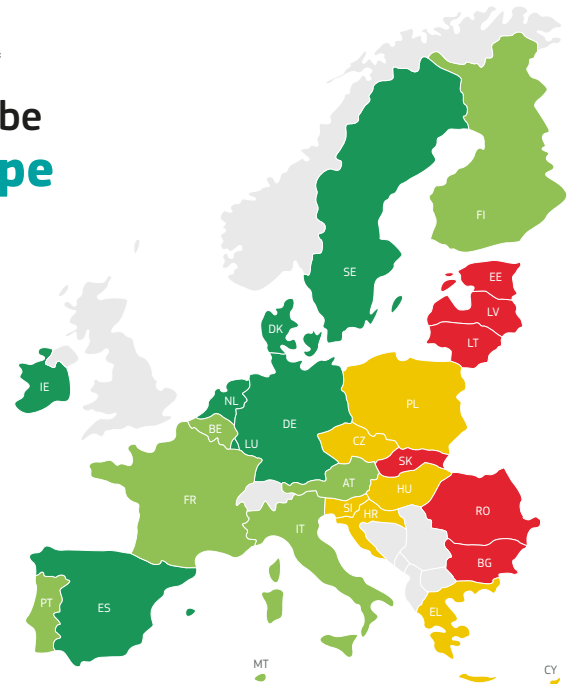


**72%** of Europeans agree\*\* that same sex marriages should be allowed throughout Europe

of EU citizens would provide **anonymous information about their sexual orientation** (for example being lesbian, gay or bisexual) if that could **help to combat discrimination**



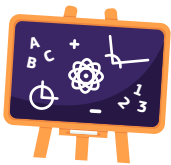
of Europeans believe that **transgender persons should be able to change their civil documents** to match their gender identity



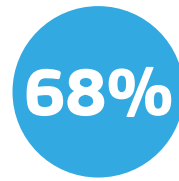
agree that **official documents should offer a third option** (X or O) besides Female and Male for those persons who do not identify as female and male

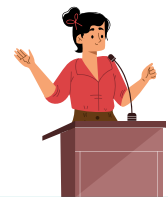
